## Subcommittee Bylaws

- 1. A subcommittee may be formed with the approval of the Board of Councilors when a particular matter for consideration arises and the President recognizes its importance.
- 2. The President shall form the subcommittee by selecting one subcommittee chair and a number of subcommittee members from among the individual (not institutional) members of the Society. Auditors may not simultaneously serve as a subcommittee member or as chair of a subcommittee.
- 3. The term of subcommittee members and of the subcommittee chair shall be determined at the time the subcommittee is formed. If a change in the terms of the members or the chair should become necessary, the terms may be reset subject to approval by the Board of Councilors.
- 4. Subcommittees are required to report their activities to the Board of Councilors and to publish them in the Memoranda and Personalia column of *Gengo Kenkyu*.
