

Subcommittee Bylaws

1. A subcommittee may be formed with the approval of the Board of Councilors when a particular matter for consideration arises and the President recognizes its importance.
2. The President shall form the subcommittee by selecting one subcommittee chair and a number of subcommittee members from among the individual (not institutional) members of the Society. Auditors may not simultaneously serve as a subcommittee member or as chair of a subcommittee.
3. The term of subcommittee members and of the subcommittee chair shall be determined at the time the subcommittee is formed. If a change in the terms of the members or the chair should become necessary, the terms may be reset subject to approval by the Board of Councilors.
4. Subcommittees are required to report their activities to the Board of Councilors and to publish them in the Memoranda and Personalia column of *Gengo Kenkyu*.
